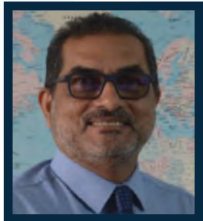
Honourable Jean-François Ferrari

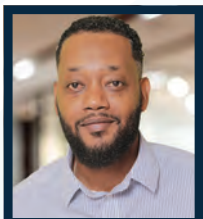
Danielle Jupiter

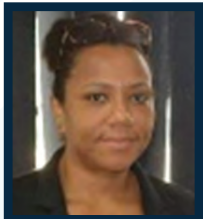
Julien Dujardin
