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# **PORTS OF GENOA** in figures

#### **TOTAL THROUGHPUT: 70 Million** *tonnes*

- □ First port in Italy
- □ Hub for 80% of Northern Italy companies

#### **CONTAINER TRAFFIC: 2.7 Million** *TEUs*

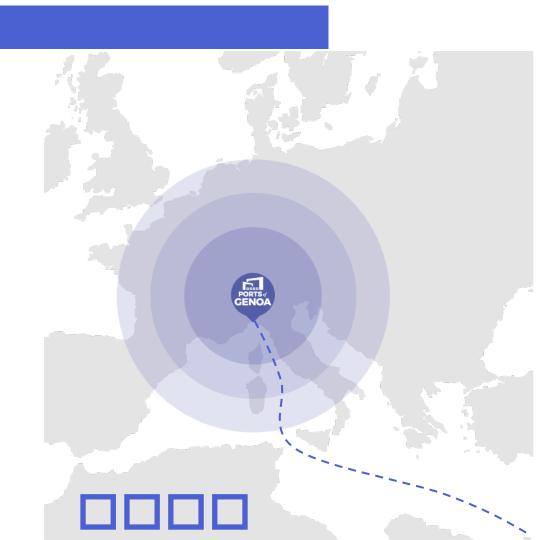
□ 6th container gateway port in Europe

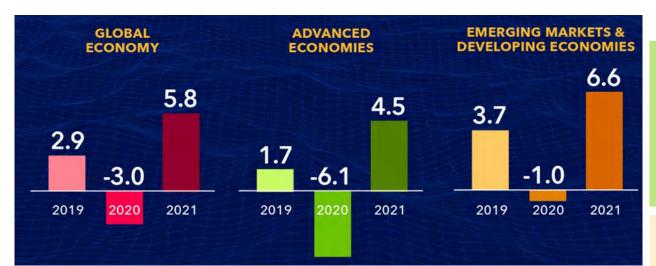
#### **PASSENGER TRAFFIC: 4.2 Million** pax

#### **LINER SHIPPING CONNECTIVITY**

- □ Over 150 deep-sea, short-sea, feeder and ro/ro liner services
- ☐ All the major shipping Companies and Alliances call the Ports of Genoa
- ☐ At the top in the Med Sea together with Valencia and Barcelona (Unctad)







- Developed countries GDP: -6.1% (FMI)
- International trade: -13% (WTO)
- □ Possible recovery in 2021: +5.8% (FMI)

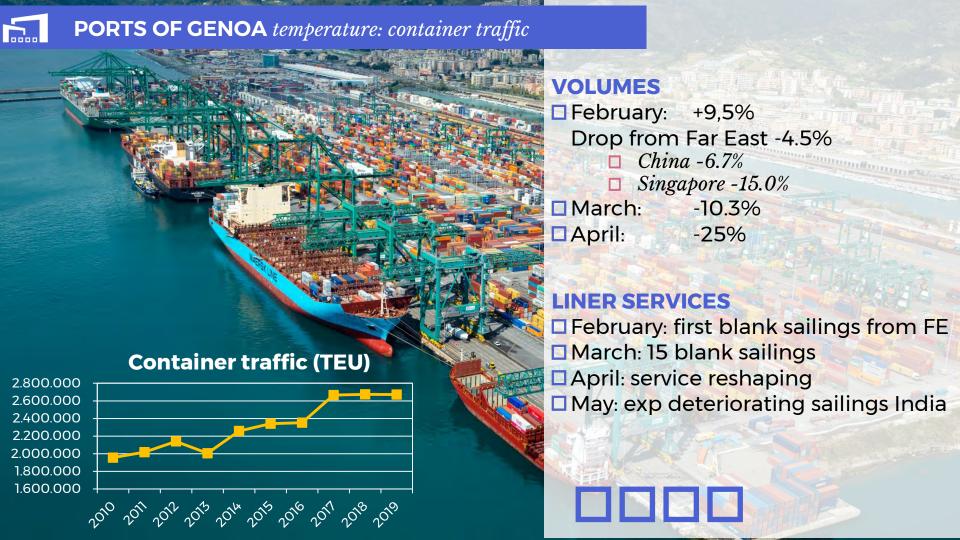
- □ GDP 2020 -6.0%
