



PORT CAPACITY in TURKEY



- → Freight handled in Turkish ports exceeds 385 million tonnes.
- → Total port capacity allows freight handling of 548 million tonnes.
- → Together with the planned investments in ports, 867 million tonnes of freight handling capacity will be available.
- → Turkish fleet has the capacity of **30,4 DWT** and ranks **13th** globally in volume.
- → The number of international ports in Turkey is 180.
















CONTAINER HANDLING CAPACITY in TURKEY





Covering Import + Export + Cabotage + Transit















HANDLING CAPACITY in TURKEY - 2014

Turkey's Hub Ports in the Marmara, Aegean and Mediterranean Sea
















MARMARA SEA – AMBARLI PORT




- → 7 Terminals
- → More than 3 million TEU handled in 2014
- → Handling capacity: approx. 40 % of Turkey, 64 % of the region
- → 179.000 vehicle transport via RO-RO in 2014
- → 7 % of Turkish Foreign Trade (USD) is being handled in Ambarli Port
- → 5000 vehicles are entering to the port every day in average




Ambarli and Other Ports in TEUs

Container (1000 X TEU)

















AEGEAN SEA – IZMIR PORT



- → More than one million TEU handling capacity
- → 10 million tonnes freight handling capacity
- → 611.000 TEU warehousing capacity
- → 525.000 m2 port area
- → 3.588 ship admission capacity per year
- → 3.386 meters of port docking length




















MEDITERRANEAN SEA – MERSIN PORT



- → 21 docks
- ◆ 1.800.000 TEU container capacity per year
- → 1.000.000 TEU handling capacity per year
- → 1.000.000 m2 port area
- → Railway connection
- → Free zone
- → 150.000 vehicle RO-RO capacity

FILYOS PORT PROJECT



- → Planned as a port complex which will serve at the north-south axis of Western Black Sea.
- → Designed to decrease the threat faced by the Turkish straits due to increased shipping traffic.
- → Its capacity will be 25 million tonnes per year.















ASYAPORT PROJECT



- → Planned as an international hub port which will serve container ships of big capacity such as Super Post Panamax ships of 13.000 TEU.
- → Its capacity will be 2.5 million TEU per year.
- → Mediterranean Shipping Company is among the financiers of the venture.















CANDARLI PORT PROJECT



- → Planned as a hub in the combined transportation chain between Europe and Middle East.
- → Biggest in Turkey and 10th biggest container port in Europe.
- → Its capacity will increase up to 12 million TEU per year
















MERSIN PORT EXPANSION PROJECT



- → Planned as a container hub to meet the future demand in East Mediterranean, Central Asia and Middle East.
- → Its capacity will be 12 million TEU per year.
