








The passing traffic > 35,000 vessels



STS Operations



- Transfer of cargo between seagoing ships positioned alongside each other, either while stationary or underway.
- Cargoes typically transferred via STS methods include crude oil, liquefied gas (LPG or LNG), bulk cargo, and petroleum products.
