



FUTURES DEVELOPMENTS FOR THE EAST PORT





- 1. Streamlining Current facilities (containter: 18 ha, Roro, breakbulk: 8 ha)
- 2. Short term development: reefer terminal upgrade,
 4+2 new STS (outreach 20 rows) 1+1 MCH able (outreach 14 rows)
- 3. Shift from coal to biomass for energy imports (storage capacity: 160 000 m3)
- 4. Relocation of the oil terminal
- **5. Development of the New Support Services area:** (85 Ha)
- 6. Container terminal extension reclaimed from the sea (2030)
