

Serious gross weight violations, OK


But how to deal with foreign containers in transit, violating axle load only?

Professionalism – driver training can improve fuel efficiency 5%-20%

5% improvement could equal \$1200 per year per truck


Kenya lost US\$4 billion annually due to road traffic fatalities...















Cutting transit costs: North-South Corridor






Cutting transit costs: Walvis Bay-Ndola-Lubumbashi Corridor






Cutting transit costs: Dar es Salaam Corridor



Cutting transit costs: Northern Corridor





