



B. OUR VISION (2014 – 2018)

C. THE KEY PROJECTS

MASTER PLAN: 2014-2018

• **54** investment operations over the 2014-2018 period.

Investment budget: 140 millions euros over 5 years.



C. THE KEY PROJECTS

- 1. A renovated container wharf: widening and deepening the container dock (15,5 m draft), and purchasing new container quay cranes (21 rows outreach).
- 2. A new 85 Ha FTZ area in the neighbourhood of the wharfs to attract logistics and industrial activities.
- 3. Implementation of a sustainable development plan including a LNG bunkering project.
- 4. A New yachting dock in connection with a waterfront project.
