




- Acquiring underperforming small/mid-sized ports and terminals turning them into leading facilities

- Efficiency through moving the supply chain out of the congested city







- Existing alternative roads around the lagoon to the wider Lagos market
- Committed expansion of key connecting roads by the authorities
- Working with authorities for a wider road network master plan
- Most importantly significant better than todays access and waiting time
