




## Luanda and Namibe Geographic Strategy









- Luanda feeds Matadi and Kinshasa;
- Import via Luanda to Congo estimated in 30% of the market;
- Zambia still a new market, but growing strong, given the cooperation and agreements between both countries;
- Luanda to Zambia route its safe and there is less boarders to cross, this reduces the cost of the final product and bureaucracy;
- Difference between both countries, it is on demand, Congo it is not as price sensitive as Zambia, however from most destinations freight rates become lower to Luanda than Matadi or Kinshasa given the number of containers discharged;
- Namibe is a key Porto not just to import to neiboring countries, but also to export fish from Namibia;
- From Namibe to Zambia by car its approximately 40h, making very attractive for the trucking companies.







# Namibe Terminal – Market outlook – Container Supply









#### **Observations:**

- In 2022, MSC had a Market Share of 86% throughout the year, but covering only less than 45% of the containers need:
- 2. At same period, CMA had a Market Share of less than 4%. For 2023, ceteris paribus, we expect lower volumes:
- In order to see their need fulfilled, the exporters have called up Breakbulk as alternative, willing to
  pay more in order to see their production exported. According to the exporters, the freight cost
  averaged close 70 USD per Ton in 2022. The bigger the Stone the lower the freight cost per
  container.
- Main market still China with 73% of BB.

There is a big market gap to be filled in order to find the balance between supply and demand, either MSC grows or CMA-CGM fill the gap, in both situations, they need to bring new volumes to Namibe.

# 2024 we will intensify our thinking on environmental way of working



#### **Iniciatives**

- We started already by changing lamps on the terminals to Led lights.
- We ordered cleaner reach stackers.
- Promote reduction on the number of trucks in the city, by using our ICD;
- Next step will be electrical trucks and RTG.

#### **Orphanage Horizonte Azul**

Location: Rua Comandante Eurico nº2, Luanda - Viana.

**Objective:** To carry out repair works to the infrastructure, food support, bus maintenance, succussion of the forces, transport, garden sealing, computer repair and implementation of computer classes, application of a water filtration system, maintenance of the generator/electro pump and fuel supply. Main target group 95 children living in the orphanage.

#### **Project Kimbo Liombembwa**

Kimbo Liombembwa Project Location: Inside the Pediatric Hospital (David Bernardino).

**Objective:** to guarantee medical and medication assistance to the children of this institution, food, accommodation, transport and psychological support during the campaigns that are carried out twice a year (May & October).

#### Hidrocefalic Hospital

Hydrocephalus Hospital Location: Headquartered in Luanda, at Rua do Mercado Kifica, street nº 141/142, in Bairro Benfica.

**Objective:** The center has as its social object the area of Health and deals with Hydrocephalus, a disease of central nervous system infection, caused by the accumulation of cerebrospinal fluid inside the cranial cavity (in the ventricles or in the subarachnoid space), which in turn, increases the intracranial pressure on the brain, which may cause damage to the brain tissue, causing an increase and swelling of the brain.

#### Panguila's School, nº380

Primary School of Kapari Panguila, nº380 Location: In Dande Municipality, before the Second Line Terminal.

**Objective:** School built by Sogester, comprising thirteen (13) classrooms, with the aim of helping the local community and inserting children into the school cycle. To guarantee a better future for the children of the municipality of Dande.

#### Little Seed Orphanage

Location: located in the Municipality of Cacuaco, Kifangondo District, on the right street of Luanda - Caxito.
