

Kazakhstan, Azerbaijan and Georgia founded Association which offers single tariff across the Trans Caspian-Black Sea international transport routes (TITR/TMTM).

Transit time 12-15 days in comparison with 45 days via the sea route.

Our corridor tariff has 10-15% advantage compared with alternative land route tariffs.

Our corridor can serve cargo flow between China and Europe using successfully two alternative routes, one of which is crossing Caspian Sea and second by using Russian Railway infrastructure (around the Caspian sea).





BTK (Baku - Tbilisi - Kars)


✓ New corridor from the Caspian Sea to Europe via Turkey (BTK) expected to be completed by the end of 2017

✓ Route crossing Georgian Railway is the shortest and the best alternative inland link that connects Turkey and China
