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

Southeast Asia ports account for significant portions of major sea-route movement...90% of cargo is transported by water worldwide & 100,000 vessels passes through the Straits of Malacca yearly.






Southeast Asia ports will continue to face demands for higher service levels and pressure on capacity


Impact to ports – planning & performance




- Peak and Lulls volumes exchange per call.
- TS hub snowball effect from other ports i.e. delays, adverse weather impact.



- Inland connectivity & ancillary infrastructure for hinterland volumes (extended gate, road, rail).
 Scalability to serve alliance partners – "mega hub".
- Entry barriers for smaller ports to compete.





- Upgrading/ new terminal operating system and technology.
- Digitalization of global trade.

- Higher crane and berth productivity.
- Flexibility to accommodate variety of vessel sizes – hub & spoke (dense feeder network).
- Reliable berth window and turnaround time.




