Shippers are still facing **container and vessel capacity shortage**



Freight rates increased to **800%** higher compared to pre-pandemic



Port congestion, lengthening port delays and cargo rollovers



Other logistics costs have increased

- Haulage costs
- Landside charges



Labour shortages in both manufacturing and logistics services sectors

- Not able to cover the high freight costs
- Rely on freight services by overseas buyer



Foreign Buyer

Absorbing **ALL** freight and insurance costs for the shipment to delay orders



Exporters / Shippers

Losing out on export revenue

MNSC recommendations to Malaysian Government



Expand the **power** of existing body such as Port Authorities to regulate and oversee all port and ancillary services.

Provide assistance to shippers in the form of **grants and tax deductions**



Establish an **Integrated National Port Management System**

Digitalisation of the processes and synchronise the SOP of the Customs Department and the OGAs




Encourage shippers to optimise the full potential of **rail connectivity** and facilitation of **road train**
