- Strategic position for the ferry traffic: competitive transit time to Balkan coountries and Greece;
- Daily departures for Greece: 3 companies operating 2 services (1-2 departures/day)
- Main Italian port on the Italy-Croatia ferry traffic (Split+Zadar in summer season. 2 companies in the summer season operating two services on the Ancona-Split route);
- Regular line to Durres.

19%: the share of the port of Ancona on the international ferry passenger traffic flows of the Italian ports





ANCONA-IGOUMENITSA-PATRAS

The European gateway to the East Med

Main ferry route of the port of Ancona. Origin and destinations of cargo traffic per Greek port:

- IGOUMENITSA: Northbound: 35% Italy; 61% Central/Western Europe; 4% Other (mainly Eastern EU Countries); Southbound: 56% Greece; 30% Turkey; 10% Bulgaria; 4% Other.
- PATRAS: Northbound: 26% Italy; 68% Central/Western Europe; 6% Other, mainly Eastern Europe. Southbound: mainly Greece.



ANCONA-CROATIA The Adriatic passenger bridge

Ancona-Split remains the only ferry line between Italy and Croatia operating all year round.

2 services during the summer season+ Ancona-Zadar route. Up to 13 calls per week in peak season.

Origin and destinations of cargo traffic:


■ Westbound: 93% Italy; 7% Other. Eastbound: Croatia 55%, BiH+MNE+SRB 43% Other 2%.

ANCONA-DURRES The fast-growing ferry line

1 service all year round

Origin and destinations of cargo traffic:


Westbound: 93% Italy; 7% Other. Eastbound: Albania 98%, Other 2%.


Port connections



- A 14 MOTORWAY (18 km away from the port. Missing link: dedicated connection
- Quadrilatero national road (Ancona-Perugia-Orte) improved to 4 lanes by the end of 2018.
- Adriatic main railway line: Core node standards achieved for train gauge, current train max length: >600 mt. Dedicated railways link between the port and the Ancona railways station (1,5 km)

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
Infrastructural development: improving intermodality



Development of the existing railway infrastructure inside the port commercial terminal. The five railway tracks will be extended from 260-300 m to 550 m.

The project includes the following steps:

- Extension of railway tracks to 550m. The railway terminal is currently located in the area dedicated to temporary storage of containers and to the loading/unloading operations
- Redesign of the existing road infrastructure. Currently 700m long, the road network will be adapted to the new terminal layout and traffic flows.
- New customs entrance to allow the extension of the railway tracks.
- Reorganization of the container yard to allow the extension of the railway tracks. The storage areas will be reorganized but it is not expected a reduction of the available space.





Innovation: Scalo Marotti

- New Custom Area dedicated to ferry traffic
- DIGITAL INNOVATION: coordinated project for a controlled itinerary and remote custom area;
- RESULT: reduction of 60.000 km/year of truck traffic

- LISY PORT COMMUNITY SYSTEM: The Port Community System supports the operators of the six ports of the network.
- ■WI FI: the port has been equipped with a free Wi-Fi network to improve the passengers' experience in port.
