



Transport hub:

 Panama serves as a transport hub for regional overseas markets

Value-added logistics hub:

 in the logistics hub, value added activities take place in Panama. These include blending, re-packing, assembling, and the like. After the value added activities, goods are delivered to end markets, both in the hinterland and overseas

Industrial complex

 Panama may serve as manufacturing site, where raw materials are transformed into intermediates and final goods.
Panama is especially attractive for manufacturing activities for which competitive supply chain costs are critical











Verbindend concept
