



The SOLAS VGM requirements apply to all packed containers as defined and applied in the International Convention of Safe Containers (CSC) which includes tank-containers, flat-racks, bulk containers etc.


There are over 35 million physical containers in circulation globally, making ~200 million trips annually (avg. of 6.7 trips per container). Container growth trends are correlated to global trade volumes which are expected to grow at a 3.5-4.0% CAGR.
