## Improving terminal operations

- The automation project started in 1996
- Patrick partnered with the Australian Centre of Field Robotics
- Brisbane Autostrad™ Terminal – opened Dec 2005
- 1<sup>st</sup> Autostrad™ operation in the world
- 3<sup>rd</sup> automated terminal globally at that time
- Template for new Sydney Autostrad™ Terminal
- Major safety improvements

## Improving terminal operations

- Patrick's largest project
- \$450 million investment
- "Cut-over" in four days
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Autostrad™ terminal
- World class in-gate processing
- 2 x 590m rail sidings
- Reliable process driven operations

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## Improving terminal operations

- Safety
  - Eliminates many high risk activities and human errors
  - Brisbane Autostrad Terminal has seen a 90% reduction in LTIFR
- Productivity and Efficiency
  - 20% less fuel and lower maintenance costs
  - Reduced cargo damage
- Culture and Diversity
  - Alters the roles of a traditional stevedore
  - Provides technology based roles in our business

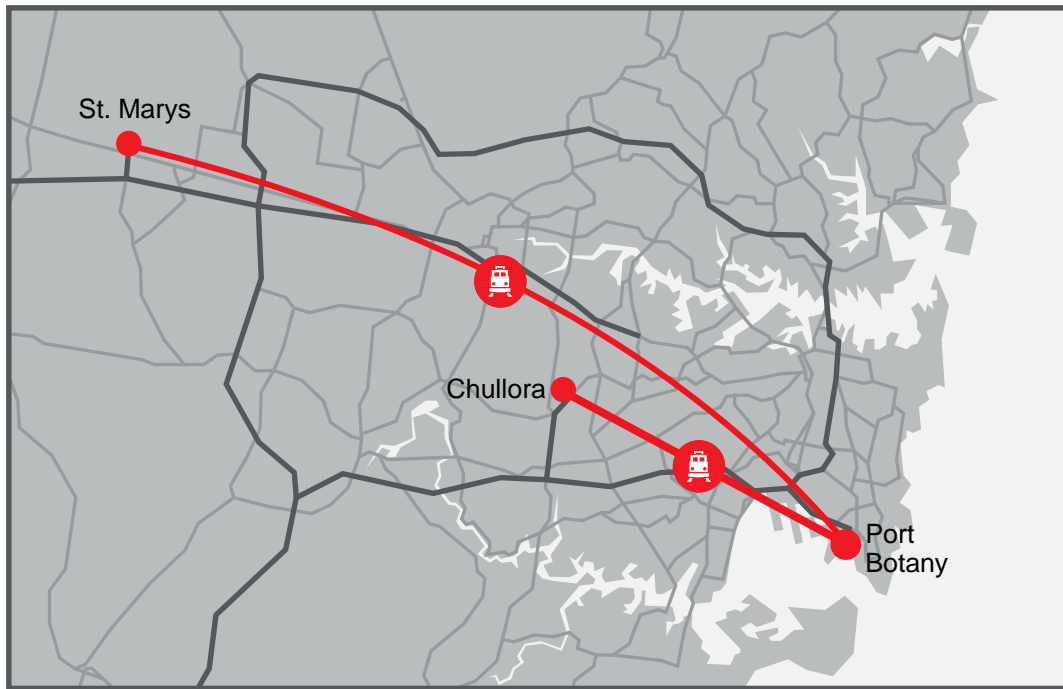

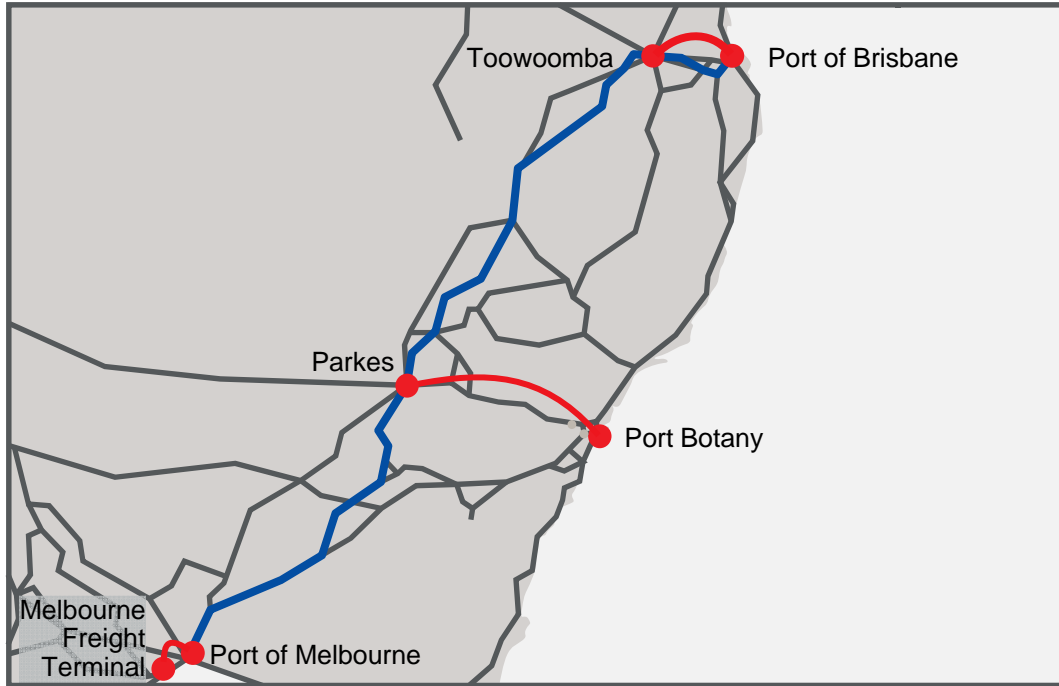
- ✓ Strategy - Stage 1: servicing inner south west
