- Independent shipping agents responsible for bunker transactions





## **Enhancing Bunker Services**



- ☐ Strategically situated on Africa's south-western coast, the Port of Walvis Bay serves as a pivotal transit hub, linking southern Africa with global destinations such as Europe, Asia, and the Americas.
- ☐ Similarly, the Port of Lüderitz, positioned further south, caters to Namibia's southern regions, and offers access to markets in South Africa's Northern Cape province.
- Engen Namibia has significantly enhanced bunkering services in the region with the 2000 MT Sarah Barge.
- □ This specialized vessel caters to rigs, support services, and passing vessels offshore at anchorage points, streamlining the bunkering process for Gasoil (10 PPM and 500 PPM) at both the Walvis Bay and Lüderitz ports





## Barge MT Sarah



- Engen Namibia is dedicated to innovation, and this is evident through its ongoing efforts to enhance customer service.
- □ The provision of bunkering services not only enhances port facilities but also consistently attracts increased cargo traffic to Southern Africa, thereby stimulating Namibia's economy and fostering job creation, both directly and indirectly.
- Although the ports of Walvis Bay and Lüderitz already receive numerous vessel visits annually, there remains a substantial number of vessels transiting without calling into port. The Barge MT Sarah effectively addresses this gap.
